



**PROCLAMATION 2022-001  
TERMINATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on March 20, 2020 at 10:55 AM, as Mayor of the Town of Lewisville, I determined and declared that a State of Emergency existed within the Town of Lewisville, North Carolina, because of the rapid spread and danger of COVID-19, which declaration was amended on March 27, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, in the intervening two years, effective vaccines and testing have been developed, causing the COVID-19 pandemic to ebb, and I have, therefore, determined that the conditions constituting a state of emergency no longer exists in the Town of Lewisville; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Centers for Disease Control has designated Forsyth County as having a "LOW" risk of infection; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Lewisville encourages its residents to stay updated on CDC guidelines and for those people with symptoms, a positive test, exposure to someone with COVID-19 or are among high risk population groups, to continue to observe masking precautions; and,

**WHEREAS**, the most effective protection against the Covid virus is to receive vaccinations and boosters.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I hereby terminate the above referenced declaration of a state of emergency and all the restrictions and orders contained therein.

**DECLARED** this the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022 at 4:30 PM.
